



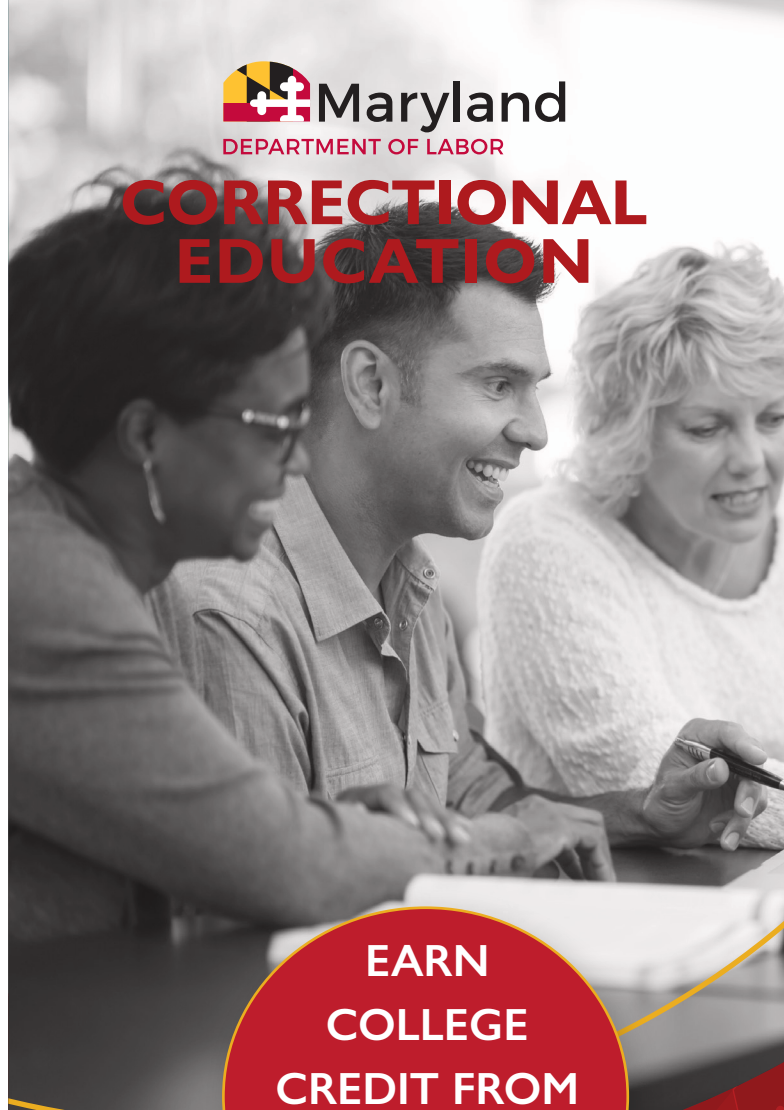

Maryland Colleges and Universities Award Credits for the GED®

How can I earn college credits from my GED?

On the GED test, a score must be 175 or higher.

Does every college award 10 credits?

Check with the college to determine if they will award 10 credits through the GED test for the program in which you will be enrolled.

College Credit for the GED® Test

GED® Scores Earn These College Credits

A score of 175 to 200 on the GED Test will earn college credits in:

- Mathematics (3 credits)
- Social Studies (3 credits)
- Science (3 credits)
- Humanities (1 credit)

Colleges That Award Credit for the GED®

In Maryland, the following colleges and universities will award up to 10 credits in selected college programs:

College Credit for the GED®

If you earn a score of 175 or better on the GED test, you will be eligible to receive 10 college credits at selected colleges and universities in the United States. In Maryland, there are 10 colleges and universities that will award credits for the GED Test in Math, Science, Social Studies, and Humanities.
